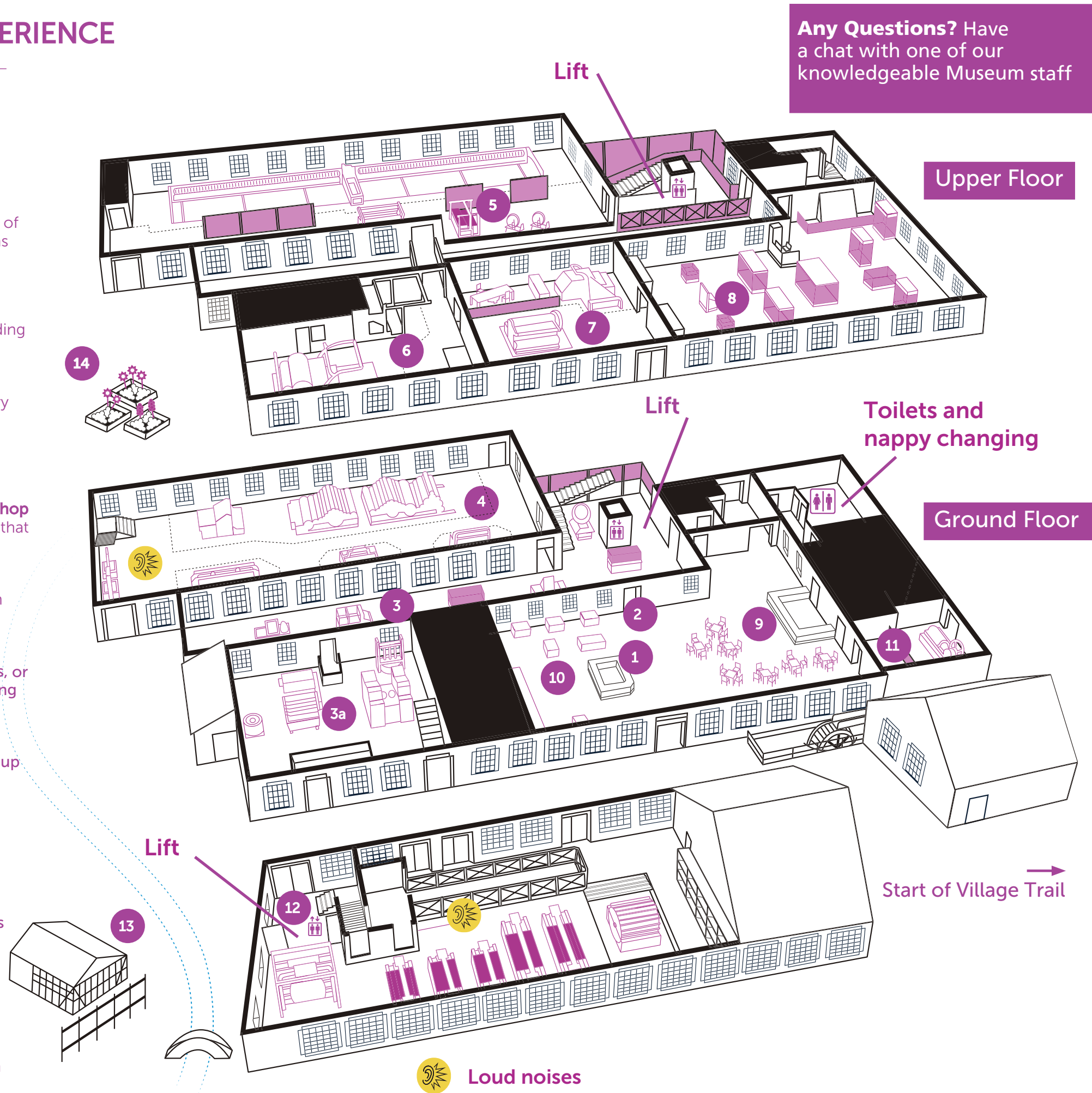


Key THE MUSEUM EXPERIENCE
